

Lady Bears take 9-AAA with ease

In the past two games with the second seed Lady Bison, Mt. Juliet has outscored them 36-10 in the fourth quarter. It was good back and forth game early, as the game was tied 10-10 late in the first. However, Mt. Juliet had a 13-3 run that lasted into the second, and Station Camp was never able to really recover, although they did get in under a double digit lead in the third. At the break, Mt. Juliet led 30-18. Going into the fourth, the Lady Bears held onto a 41-28 lead.
